DIRECTIONS:

From I-83 S– take the Exit 16-A (Route 74 South/South Queen Street; Travel 4 miles into Dallastown. Turn right at the 2nd traffic light onto South Pleasant Avenue. After traveling ¾ of a mile on South Pleasant Avenue bear right at the ‘Y’ onto New School Lane to proceed to the school.

The secondary campus includes the middle and high school. Take first left after passing the tennis courts on your right and park near baseball field. Additional parking is around the side of the school. Please enter back of MS at door #25.

From Lancaster: From 30 West – take the exit toward PA-462/Hallam, turn left onto Kreutz Creek Rd (signs for PA-462/Hallam); continue on Freysville Road, turn right on Lombard Rd, continue on N. Main Street/Lombard Street, turn right on E. Broad Street, turn left on N. Pleasant Ave. – continue straight on New School Lane. (see directions above).

From I-83 N– take the exit for PA 214 toward Loganville. Follow Rte 214 to Melvale Rd and bear L to school.

All individual events count 5 pts. for entering each event, plus points for awards: 5pts. for 1st, 4 pts. for 2nd, 3 pts. for 3rd, 2 pts. for 4th, 1 pt. for 5th. (Level 1 (Sp. Beginner) Solo and Spec. Beginner Basic not included.)

GROUPS: AGES: Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9);
Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15 +)

New! All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-9 members); Large (10+ members)

Dance Twirl - Use own music; one baton only; no props; Time: 1 ½ - 3 minutes

Level 1 Dance Twirl (same as above; twirls restricted to no more than a 1 turn)

Twirl Teams – march music; Time: 1 ½ - 3 minutes

Duet Strut & Strut Teams -Use own music; Time: 1 – 3 minutes

Novelty/Show Teams - must use some prop or equipment instead of, or in addition to standard baton – 1 ½ - 3 minutes

Pom Teams – 1½ -3 minutes

New! **Dance Teams** – any type of dance (soft shoe only, no Taps); 1½ -3 minutes

Corps: Floor, Street Parade, Mini & Production - 10 members minimum

School Majorette Squads (Jr/Sr/College) - Short Program/ Long Program

Color Guard – Jr (0-14.9) Sr (15.0+) Sm or Lg; Short: 2-4 minutes; Long: 4-8 min

INDIVIDUAL OPEN EVENTS

Beg. Dress Model – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over (Time Limit 1:30 Max.)

Int. & Adv. Dress Model – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over (Time: 1:30 Max.)

Beg. Costume Model (Best App.) Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: 1:30 Max

Int. & Adv. Costume Model (Best Appearing) – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Nov., Beg, Int, and Adv. Fancy Strut – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over
(No specific pattern required –Time limit is 2 minutes maximum)

Special Beg. Basic March – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
(Has not won TWO 1st places in Basic March)

Beg. Basic March – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

Adv. Basic March – Age: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

Beg. & Adv. Military March – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo– No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.

Level 2 (Novice) Solo – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2 min.

Level 3 (Beginner) Solo– No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.

Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2 ½ min

Level 5 (Advanced) Solo - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.

Boys/Mens Solo – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.

Feature Twirler Solo – Open to ANY twirler age 15+. Combo of 1baton & novelty; standard march music – time: 1½ to 2 ½; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.

Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit – same as solo classification. PA residents only

Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit is same as solo classification. Out of state residents only

Beg. Int, & Adv. Two-Baton– Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: 1½ to 2 minutes

Beg. & Adv. Three-Baton Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: ½ - 2 minutes

Duet Twirl – Avg. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March Music; Time: 1 ½ -2 ½ min.

+Solo Dance Twirl - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ use own music; 1 baton only

+Solo Show Routine —*New!* **Beg. & Adv** - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Use own music - any type of dance with baton & novelty

(Beg. Time :30-2 minutes; Adv Time: 1½ to 2 ½ minutes)

+Duet Show Routine –Use own music; novelties optional; Time: 1½ - 3 min.

+Solo Pom – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1½ min. max – use own music)

+Duet Pom – Same as Solo Pom – use averaged ages

+Color Guard Solo or Rifle Solo – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes

+Color Guard Duet or Rifle Duet – Same as Solo; Use Avg. Ages

+ these events must be entered by Apr 23 to be eligible to compete for awards

Rating Festival – performance for a rating only. Not a competition. All participants receive a ribbon. For Level 1 (Special Beginner) solo twirlers only.
