From Columbus, OH & Southeast: Take US 30 W to I 69 N in Indiana Take Exit 348 for US 20 toward LaGrange. Follow US 20 W approx. 8 miles to S 1150 E and turn L. Building will be on the left

From Indianapolis: Hwy 69 North to Exit 348 and follow directions above.

From Toledo, Cleveland, Canton & Northern OH: Take Rte 80 (Turnpike) West. Exit on OH Rte 49 N then turn L on US 20 W and follow directions above.

From Illinois/Northwest IN: Take I 80 E to I 94. Take exit 40A for US 20 E toward S Bend. Continue straight on IN-2 E around S Bend and merge again onto US 20 E. Follow to S 1150 E and turn R — Building will be on the left

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. One of the philosophies of Twirling Unlimited is that there is too much unnecessary publicity by individual twirlers. This results in distrust by the media and a ho-hum attitude on the part of the public when a truly outstanding honor is achieved. In keeping with this, ALL the publicity concerned with Twirling Unlimited Regional Competition will be handled through our headquarters. Each contestant winning first place and each group winning first place will be given official press releases. These in turn are to be submitted to the media newspapers, televisions, etc. No publicity relating to TU contests is to be submitted in any way other than the official press releases. Failure to comply with this standard will result in rejection of future entries and participation in TU competitions.
- 2. Lanes for all Regional and Open events will be posted. It is the obligation of the twirler to report to each lane if you have a conflict. No changing of position in regional competition will be allowed.
- 3. Awards for all open events will be presented immediately. Awards for Regional events and pageants will be presented at the end of the competition.
- 4. Building owner, contest director, Twirling Unlimited or contest sponsor are not responsible for accidents, property loss or injuries.
- 5. Remember: REGIONAL does not denote a geographic restriction. Contestants from any location or any organization are welcome to compete at every TU Regional competition.
- 6. In order to be eligible to compete in any pageant, a twirler must also enter at least one "non-pageant" solo (either Regional, State or open solo).
- 7. Spectator admission: \$5 for adults; \$3 for non-competing children.

MISS TU REGIONAL MAJORETTE (Including SENIOR division)!

Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17, 18 & Over (*Use your age as of day of contest*) Note: The designation "Regional" does not restrict the contestants who may enter, they may live in any location.

This is a Three-part Contest.

A. MODELING

All divisions optional dress length or Costume. Model 50%; Interview 50%

B. COMPETITION SOLO

One baton only - time limit 1½ to 2½ minutes Performed to standard march record

C. SHOW ROUTINE or SOLO DANCE TWIRL

Performed to taped music of the contestant's choice. Any type of twirl with dance moves are permitted (novelties optional). Time is 1½ to 2½ minutes. Timing will begin and end with the music. (Performance music should be ready to begin the competition when your event is scheduled! If you use a CD or iPod, please bring your own player as backup, in case of technical difficulties.)

Contestants must compete in all 3 aspects of this competition and the winner will be determined using equal credit for all 3 parts. *Note: Twirlers must also enter at least one "non-pageant" solo to be eligible to compete in the pageant.*

Awards: 1-3 Trophies, TU Regional Majorette winners also receive flowers, banner & \$25 for Savings Bond; Individual medallions for 1-3 in Model, Solo, Show Twirl

STATE SOLO CHAMPIONSHIPS (INDIANA)

Indiana State Solo Champions - open to residents of Indiana only. Time limit is 1½ to 2½ minutes from salute to salute. Divisions: 0-8, 9-11,12-14, 15 & Over.

REGIONAL SOLO (Including separate SENIOR division!)

The designation "Regional" does not restrict the contestants who may enter; they may live in any location.

Divisions: *Individual ages* (0-6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16, 17,18,19, 20 & over) *for preliminaries*! Trophy for 1st place - the top 2 in <u>each age</u> category will retwirl for the regional title. TwirlOff Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17 and 18+. Awards will be a trophy for 1st, 2nd & 3rd. Flowers, banner for Regional title winners.

REGIONAL FANCY STRUT

No specific pattern required - time limit is 2 minutes maximum. Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over.

REGIONAL DUET TWIRL

Time limit 1½ to 2½ minutes, March Music, Ages (Avg) 0-8.5, 9-11.5, 12-14.5, 15+

REGIONAL DUET STRUT

Straight Line (may re-trace), Use Own Music; Time Limit: 1½ to 3 min. – Ages(Avg.): 0-8.5, 9-11.5, 12-14.5, 15+

REGIONAL TWO BATON & REGIONAL THREE BATON

Time limit is $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 minutes for 2-Baton; $\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 minutes for 3-Baton. Age Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

BEGINNER (Level 3) & INTERMEDIATE (Level 4) PAGEANTS

Age Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Contestants will compete in Model (either costume or dress), Twirl & Fancy Strut. (Twirl level determines Pageant level). *Note: Twirlers must also enter at least one "non-pageant" solo to be eligible to compete in the pageant.*

Awards: Banner, Trophy & Flowers for winners. 3 place awards in model, twirl & strut and 3 places overall. 4 & 5th place overall if more than 15 contestants.

BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT

Restricted to <u>Level 1 and Level 2</u> (Special Beginner & Novice) twirlers ONLY. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+. Contestants will compete in Basic March, Costume Model & Solo. *Note: twirlers must also enter at least one "non-pageant" solo (open, Regional or State) to be eligible to compete in the pageant.*Awards: 3 place awards in March, Solo and Costume Model. 3 place winners overall. 4th & 5th overall for divisions that have 15 contestants or more.

REGIONAL GROUP COMPETITION

(Please bring your own player or music system as backup in case of technical difficulties.

GROUP AGES: Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9); Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15.0 & over)

Corps: Minimum of 10 twirling members

Street Parade Corps - Do a U formation; 2 min. time limit

Mini Corps - 2 to 4 min. time limit. No formation required

Floor Corps - 5 to 9 min. time limit.

<u>Production Groups</u> – 5- 9 min. time limit

All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-10); Large (11+)

<u>Dance Twirl</u> – Use own music; 1 baton only, Time limit: 1 ½ - 3 minutes

Twirl Teams Use standard march music. 1 ½ -3 minutes

Poms - Use own music; Time Limit: 1½ - 3 minutes

Novelty Teams – Use any equipment other than one baton; 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 3 min.

Strut Teams - Use own music; Time Limit: 1 - 3 min.

<u>Color Guard</u> (Jr & Sr) Short Program or Long Program, use own music <u>Dance Lines</u> – (All types against each other) Time Limit: 1:30-3:00

Open Group Event:

<u>Level 1 Dance Twirl Teams</u>. For new and developing teams – <u>Level of tricks</u> restricted: no member may do more than a 1 turn/ 2 elbows/No high toss tricks with illusions or any gymnastics underneath. Awards: Level 1 medallions for ea. member

INDIVIDUAL OPEN EVENTS

- Beg. Dress Model: length of dress optional; time limit is $1\frac{1}{2}$ minutes Max Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Int. & Adv. Dress Model: length of dress is optional; time limit is 1 ½ minutes Max. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Beg. Costume Model: with or without a baton time is 1 ½ minutes Max. Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Int. & Adv. Costume Model: with or without a baton time limit is 1 ½ minutes Max. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Novice, Beg. & Int. Fancy Strut no specific pattern required. Time limit is 2 minutes Max. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Beg. Basic March marching performed in a square singly or follow-the-leader (judge's discretion). Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Adv. Basic March performed in a square singly or follow-the-leader (judge's discretion). Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.

All Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

- Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo Has not won TWO 1st places in solo competition. Time limit is 1 to 2 minutes. No more than 1 spin/ 2 elbows
- Level 2 (Novice) Solo has not won 3 additional first places in solo (total of 5) Time limit is 1½ - 2 minutes No more than 2 spins/ 4 elbows
- Level 3 (Beginner) Solo –has not won 5 additional first places in solo (total of 10)

 Time Limit: 1½ to 2 minutes

 No more than 3 spins/ 6 elbows.
- Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo has not won 8 addt'l 1st places in solo (total of 18) Time 1½ to 2¼ min. No more than 4 spins/ 8 elbows
- Level 5 (Advanced) Solo Time limit is 2 to 2 ½ minutes No restrictions
- Boys Solo Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time Limit: 1 ½ 2 ½ minutes
- Feature Twirler Solo Open to ANY twirler age 15+; March Music Combination of 1 baton & any novelty. Time: $2 2 \frac{1}{2}$ minutes (1 baton minimum of 1 min.).
- Beg. & Int. Two-Baton- Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ $\,$ Time limit is $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 minutes
- Beg. Three-Baton - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time limit ½ -2 minutes
- Beginner Duet Twirl March Music Avg Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time limit: 1½ to 2 minutes
- Color Guard or Rifle Solo or Duet Use own music
 Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Duet use Avg Age) Time is 3 minutes maximum
