**DIRECTIONS:**

**From Altoona:** take PA 36 through Ashville. Come to a fork and keep R onto Colonel Drake Hwy. There will be a sharp right onto Glendale Lake Rd (if you pass Sheetz you've gone too far). The school will be on the left.

**From Pittsburgh and Southwest:** Take 22 to 219 N Turn R onto E Carroll St, which turns into Mellon Ave. When Mellon Ave turns L, it becomes Park Ave, then soon you take a slight R onto 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. In ¼ mile, turn R onto Magee Ave. and L at light in Patton (Sheetz will be on L). Keep left onto Glendale Lake Rd and school will be on the left.

**From Butler, Kittanning and Indiana, PA:** take 422 E to 553 E. Turn L onto 219 N, then turn R onto E Carroll St and follow directions above.

*No personal chairs allowed on gym floor for anyone under the age of 60!  
(except wheelchairs)*

(Level 1 (Spec. Beg.) Solo and Spec. Beg. Basic not included.).

AGES: Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9);

Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15.0+)

*New!* All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-9 members); Large (10+ members)

**Dance Twirl** - Use own music; one baton only; No props; Time: 1 ½ - 3 minutes

**Level 1 Dance Twirl** (same as above; twirls restricted to no more than a 1 turn)

**Twirl Teams** – march music; Time: 1 ½ - 3 minutes

**Duet Strut & Strut Teams** -Use own music; Time: 1 – 3 minutes

**Novelty/Show Teams** - must use some prop or equipment instead of, or in addition to standard baton – 1 ½ - 3 minutes

**Pom Teams** – 1½ -3 minutes

**Production Groups:** 10 members minimum; Time: 5-9 minutes

**Corps:** Floor, Street Parade & Mini - 10 twirling members minimum

**School Majorette Squads** (Jr/Sr/College) - Short Program/ Long Program

**Color Guard** – Jr (0-14.9) Sr (15.0+)/ Sm or Lg Short: 2-4 minutes; Long: 4-8 min

## INDIVIDUAL OPEN EVENTS

**Beg. Dress Model** – Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time Limit 1:30 Max.

**Int. & Adv. Dress Model** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time 1:30 Max.

**Beg. Costume Model** - Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

**Int. & Adv. Costume Model** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

**Nov., Beg. Int. & Adv. Fancy Strut** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

(No specific pattern required – Time limit: 2 minutes maximum)

**Spec. Beg. Basic March** (Has not won TWO 1<sup>st</sup> places in Basic March)

Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

**Beginner Basic March** – Ages 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March in a square

**Advanced Basic March** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March in a square

**Beg. & Adv. Military March** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

*NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.*

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

**Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo** – No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.

**Level 2 (Novice) Solo** – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2 min.

**Level 3 (Beginner) Solo** – No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.

**Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo** – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min

**Level 5 (Advanced) Solo** - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.

**Boys Solo** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.

**Feature Twirler Solo** – Open to ANY twirler age 15+. Combo of 1 baton & novelty; standard march music – time: 1½ to 2 ½; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.

**Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit – same as solo classification; Pennsylvania residents only

**Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors Solo** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit: same as solo classification. Out of state residents only

**Beg., Int., Adv. 2 Baton** Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time Limit 1½ to 2 minutes)

**Beg. & Adv. 3-Baton** Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit ½ - 2 minutes)

**Duet Twirl** – Ages: 0-8.5, 9-11.5, 12-14.5, 15+ (averaged ages)

Use standard march music - Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ minutes

**+Solo Dance Twirl** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ use own music; 1 baton only

**+Solo Show Routine** —*New!* **Beg. & Adv** - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Use own music - any type of dance with baton & novelty

(Beg. Time :30-2 minutes; Adv Time: 1½ to 2 ½ minutes)

**+Duet Show Routine** – Use own music; novelties optional; Time: 1½ - 3 min.

**+Solo Pom** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1½ min. max – use own music)

**+Duet Pom** – Same as Solo Pom – use averaged ages

**+Color Guard Solo or Rifle Solo** – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes

**+Color Guard Duet or Rifle Duet** – Same as Solo; Use Avg. Ages

+ these events must be entered by Apr 23 to be eligible to compete for awards

**Rating Festival** – performance for a rating only. Not a competition and all participants receive a ribbon. For Level 1 (Special Beginner) twirlers only

**Interview Clinic Lane** – Interview practice for judge's comments; not a competition
