DIRECTIONS:

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike -Exit at Bedford and take I-99 (Route 220) N. to the 17th St. Exit in Altoona. Follow the signs to downtown Altoona. Turn R at the corner of 17th St. and Rte 764 N. (Sixth Ave.) Look for the AASD's Electronic Message Board at this intersection. Altoona Area High School is located on Route 764 N. approximately 300 yards from this intersection on the right.

From the West (Via Rte 22) and South - Follow I-99 (Route 220) N. to the 17th St. Exit in Altoona. Follow the signs to downtown Altoona. Turn R at the corner of 17th St. and Rte 764 N. (Sixth Ave.). Follow directions above.

From the North – Follow (Route 220) S. to the 17th St. Exit in Altoona. Follow the signs to downtown Altoona. Turn R at the corner of 17th St. and Rte. 764 North (Sixth Ave.). Follow Directions above.

From the East Via Rte 22- Exit Rte 22 W in Frankstown. Look for directional signs to I-99 (Rte. 220). Follow Frankstown Rd. to Altoona. When you reach I-99 (Rte. 220), travel one exit NORTH to the 17th St. Exit. Follow the same directions as listed above.

Twirl Teams – Standard march music; 1 baton only; Time: 1½ - 3 minutes

Duet Strut & Strut Teams -Use own music; Time: 1 – 3 minutes; 1 baton only

Novelty/Show Teams - must use some prop or equipment instead of, or in addition to standard baton – 1½ - 3 minutes

Pom Teams – 1½ -3 minutes

Production Groups: 10 members minimum; Time: 5-9 minutes

Corps: Floor, Street Parade & Mini - 10 twirling members minimum

Majorette Squads (Jr/Sr/College) - Short Program/ Long Program

Color Guard – Jr (0-14.9) Sr (15.0+) Sm or Lg/ Short: 2-4 minutes; Long: 4-8 min

INDIVIDUAL OPEN EVENTS

Beg. Dress Model – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over (Time Limit 1:30 Max.)

Int. & Adv. Dress Model – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1:30 max.)

Beg. Costume Model (Best App.) Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time 1:30 max)

Int. & Adv. Costume Model (Best App.) Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (time: 1:30 max)

Nov. & Beg, Int, and Adv. Fancy Strut – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over

(No specific pattern required –Time limit is 2 minutes maximum)

Special Beg. Basic March – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

(Has not won TWO 1st places in Basic March)

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo – No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.

Level 2 (Novice) Solo – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1½ - 2 min.

Level 3 (Beginner) Solo– No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1½ - 2 min.

Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1½ - 2¼ min.

Level 5 (Advanced) Solo - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2½ min.

Boys/Mens Solo – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1½ to 2½ min.

Feature Twirler Solo – Open to ANY twirler age 15+. Combo of 1 baton &

novelty; 1 baton minimum of 1 minute.; march music; time: 1½ -2½ minutes

Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit – same as solo classification; PA residents only

Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit- same as solo classification. Out of state residents only

Beg., Int., Adv. 2 Baton Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time Limit 1½ to 2 minutes)

Beg. & Adv. 3-Baton Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit ½ - 2 minutes)

Duet Twirl – Ages: 0-8.5, 9-11.5, 12-14.5, 15+ (averaged ages)

+Solo Pom – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1½ min. max – use own music)

+Duet Pom – Same as Solo Pom – use averaged ages

+Color Guard Solo or Rifle Solo – Use own music, Jr or Sr, Time: Max. 3 minutes

+Color Guard Duet or Rifle Duet – Same as Solo; Use Avg. Ages

Rating Festival – performance for a rating only. Not a competition and all participants receive a ribbon. For Level 1 (special beginner) solo only!

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over

Duet Ages (averaged): 0-8.5, 9-11.5, 12-14.5, 15+

DANCE LINES

Categories: Same as above plus Dance Production
 (Poms see twirling brochure)

Ages: PeeWee – average age up to 6.9
 Tiny Tot - average age from 7.0 to 8.9
 Juvenile - average age from 9.0 to 11.9
 Junior - average age from 12.0 to 14.9
 Senior - average age from 15.0 and Up

Divisions: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-9 members); Large (10+ members)

Group Time limit is 1:30 to 3 minutes

Most Athletic Associations restrict mounts. Groups may use one tier high in competition. Any groups using mounts do so with the understanding that they are exclusively responsible in case of injury. There are no mats.
