From Southern MI/Ohio:

75 North to 275 North toward Flint
Exit 165 (toward Port Huron) & stay on M5 North (merges left).
At the roundabout take the THIRD exit to go West on Pontiac Trail
At first light (Welch Road) turn Right
Stay on Welch Road until it dead ends at Oakley Park Road. Turn left.
Turn Right on S Commerce Rd
Turn Left on W Commerce Rd
Turn right on N Commerce Rd (which turns into Bogie Lake Rd)
At first traffic light turn left into school's main entrance. At the stop sign, turn left & park in the adjacent lot to the school. 2nd set of doors is gym entrance.

From Western MI:

I 96 East, Get off at exit 159 (Wixom)
Turn Left onto Wixom Road go about 4 miles to Glengary Road
Turn right onto Glengary Road and go about 2 miles
Turn left onto Benstein Road and go about 2 miles until it dead ends
Turn right onto Sleeth Road about 1/2 mile.
Turn left onto N. Commerce Road (N.Commerce becomes Bogie Lake Rd.)
School is 1.5 miles down on the left. Follow above directions into parking lot.

HIGH POINT AWARD to solo twirler with most points earned. Nov/Beg., Int., Adv. (division determined by solo classification). All solo events count 5 pts. for entering each event, plus points for awards: 5pts. for 1st, 4 pts. for 2nd, 3 pts. for 3rd, 2 pts. for 4th and 1 pt for 5th. (Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo and Special Beginner Basic not included.). 40 points minimum (forms available at registration desk).

GROUPS: Ages: Pee Wee (0- 6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9); Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15 & Up)

New! All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-9 members); Large (10+)

Dance Twirl Teams– Use own music; No Props; 1 baton only, 1½-3 minutes

Level 1 Dance Twirl (same as above; twirls restricted to no more than a 1 turn)

Twirl Teams – march music; 1 ½ - 3 minutes

Duet Strut & Strut Teams – Use own music; 1 – 3 minutes

Novelty/Show Teams – must use some prop or equipment instead of, or in addition to standard baton – 1 ½ - 3 minutes

Pom Teams – Use own music; No props 1 ½ to 3 minutes

Majorette Squads (Jr Hi/Sr Hi/College) – Short Program/ Long Program

Color Guard – Junior and Senior; Short Program/ Long Program

Production Groups: 10 members minimum; 5- 9 minutes

Corps: Floor, Street Parade and Mini – 10 baton twirling members minimum

INDIVIDUAL OPEN EVENTS

Beg. Dress Model – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over (Time Limit 1:30 Max.)

Int. & Adv. Dress Model – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over (Time: 1:30 Max.)

Beg. Costume Model (Best App) –Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1:30 Max)

Int. & Adv. Costume Model (Best App) – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1:30 Max)

Nov., *Beg, Int, and Adv. Fancy Strut – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over

(No specific pattern required –Time limit is 2 minutes maximum)

* Special awards – see front of brochure

Special Beg. Basic March – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

(Not won TWO 1st places in Basic March)

Beg. Basic March – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

Adv. Basic March – Age: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

Beg. & Adv. Military March – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo – No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.

Level 2 (Novice) Solo – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.

Level 3 (Beginner) Solo– No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1½ - 2 min.

Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1½ - 2½ min.

Level 5 (Advanced) Solo - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.

Boys Solo – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.

Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit – same as solo classification; Michigan residents only

Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit - same as solo classification. Out of state residents only

Feature Twirler Solo –Open to ANY twirler age 15+ Combination of one-baton & novelty; use standard march music – time: 2 to 2 ½ min.; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.

Beg. Int. & Adv. Two-Baton– Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit 1½ -2 min.)

Beg. & Adv. Three-Baton Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time limit: ½ - 2 min.)

Duet Twirl – Avg. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ March Music; Time: 1 ½ -2 ½ min.

+Solo Dance Twirl - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ use own music; 1 baton only

+Solo Show Routine — **Beg. & Adv** - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Use own music - any type of dance with baton & novelty

(Beg.Time :30-2 minutes; Adv Time: 1½ to 2 ½ minutes)

+Duet Show Routine–Use own music, Novelty optional; Avg ages Time: 1:30-3:00

+Solo Pom – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: 1 ½ min. max – use own music

+Duet Pom – Same as Solo Pom, Use averaged ages

+Color Guard or Rifle/Sabre Solo – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes

+Color Guard Duet or Rifle Duet – Same as Solo; Use Avg. Ages

+These events must be entered by Jan 15 to be eligible to compete for awards

Rating Festival – performance for a rating only. Not a competition. For new twirlers-all participants receive a ribbon. For Level 1(Special Beg) Solo only

Interview Clinic Lane – Interview practice for judge's comments; not a competition
