From I-79/I-77: Merge onto 1-64 West via exit 101 toward Huntington Take Kanawha Turnpike Exit 55, toward WV-601 (0.3 mi) Slight left onto Kanawha Turnpike (1.7 mi) Turn left at light onto Chestnut Street, then take right onto Eagle Way

From West or Northwest (Columbus, OH, Huntington, WV): Take I-64 E

Take the WV-25 Exit 53, and keep Left toward Dunbar Turn left onto 10th St/WV-25. Continue to follow 10th St. (0.3 mi) 10th Street becomes Dunbar Bridge (0.2 mi) then turn slight right (0.06 mi) Turn right onto MacCorkle Ave SW/US60 (0.3mi) Turn right onto Chestnut Street and turn right onto Eagle Way

Level 2 (Novice) Solo – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2 min.
Level 3 (Beginner) Solo – No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.
Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min
Level 5 (Advanced) Solo - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.

Boys/Mens Solo – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ min.
Feature Twirler Solo –Open to ANY twirler age 15+; combination of 1baton & novelty; standard march music; time: 1½ to 2 ½; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.
Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit – same as solo classification; WV residents only – open to boys & girls
