DIRECTIONS:

From 401 take the Highway 19 Ingersoll cut off (Elmhurst Inn) toward Ingersoll. Turn right on Harris on curve (variety store on left side). Go to Charles Street and turn left. Turn right on Mutual Street (Canadian Tire on your right). Follow on Mutual Street (pass Arena on your left, police station on right). Turn left 2nd street past the 4-way stop. This runs into school.

From other side of Highway 19 – 19 turns into Bell Street. Turn left at stop (Macs & Catholic Church) Turn right on next street and L at the next. This will be Alma Street and school will be on your left.

HIGH POINT TROPHY to Solo Twirler with most points earned – Nov/Beg., Int. & Adv. (Division determined by solo twirling classification). All individual events count 5 pts. for entering each event, plus pts. for awards: 5 pts. for 1st, 4 pts. for 2nd, 3 pts. for 3rd, 2 pts. for 4th, and 1 pt. for 5th. (Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo, Special Beginner Basic not included) 40 pts. Minimum; Forms at registration table

GROUPS: AGES: Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9);
Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15+)

- All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-10 members); Large (11+ members)
- Dance Twirl** - Use own music; No Props; Time: 1 ½ - 3 minutes
- Level 1 Dance Twirl** (same as above; twirls restricted to no more than a 1 turn)
- Twirl Teams** – march music; Time: 1 ½ - 3 minutes
- Duet Strut & Strut Teams** -Use own music; Time: 1 – 3 minutes
- Novelty/Show Teams** - must use some prop or equipment instead of, or in addition to standard baton – 1 ½ - 3 minutes
- Pom Teams** – 1½ -3 minutes
- Production Groups:** 10 members minimum; Time: 5-9 minutes
- Corps:** Floor, Street Parade & Mini - 10 twirling members minimum
- School Majorette Squads** (Jr/Sr/College) - Short Program/ Long Program
- Color Guard** – Jr (0-14.9) Sr (15.0+) Sm or Lg Short: 2-4 minutes; Long: 4-8 min

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

- Beg. Dress Model** – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over (Time Limit: Max. 1:30)
- Int. & Adv. Dress Model** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
- Beg. Costume Model** - Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time Limit: Max 1:30)
- Int. & Adv. Costume Model** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Nov., Beg, Int. & Adv. Fancy Strut** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
- Special Beg. Basic March** - Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over
(Has not won TWO 1st places in Basic March) Awards are rosettes or medals
- Beg. Basic March** - Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over
- Adv. Basic March** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over
- Beg. & Adv. Military March** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over

NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.

Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

- Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo**– No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.
- Level 2 (Novice) Solo** – No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2 min.
- Level 3 (Beginner) Solo**– No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.
- Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo** – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min
- Level 5 (Advanced) Solo** - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.
- Boys Solo** - Age: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over (Time 1 ½ to 2 ½ minutes)
- Feature Twirler Solo** – Open to ANY twirler age 15+. Combo of 1 baton & novelty; standard march music – time: 1½ to 2 ½; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.
- Beg., Int., & Adv. Canadian Solo** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over
(Time Limit - Same as Solo Classification) Canadian residents only.
- Beg., Int. & Adv. U. S. Solo** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over
(Time Limit - Same as Solo classification) US residents only
- Beg. Int. & Adv., Two-Baton** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: 1 ½ to 2 minutes
- Beg. & Adv. Three-Baton** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over; Time: ½ to 2 min.
- Duet Twirl** – March Music, Avg. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1 ½ -2 ½ min.)

- +Solo Dance Twirl/Freestyle** - use own music; 1 baton only Time : 1:30-2:30
- +Duet Freestyle** – use own music; 1 baton only; Use Avg. ages; Time 1½ - 3 min.
- +Solo Show Routine** —*New!* **Beg. & Adv** - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
Use own music - any type of dance with baton & novelty
(Beg. Time :30-2 minutes; Adv Time: 1½ to 2 ½ minutes)
- +Duet Show Routine** –Use own music; same as Solo Show; Time: 1½ - 3 min.
- +Solo Pom** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: 1½ min. max – use own music
- +Duet Pom** – same as Solo Pom; Use Avg Ages
- +Color Guard/Rifle Solo or Duet** – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes
+ these events must be entered by May 8 to be eligible to compete for awards

Rating Festival – performance for a rating only. Not a competition. All participants receive a ribbon. For Level 1 (Special Beginner) twirlers only.

Interview Clinic Lane: Interview practice for comment sheet– open to all levels

BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT – 3 parts: Costume Model, Basic March and Solo

Open to Level 1 (Special Beginner) and Level 2 (Novice) twirlers only!

Note: Twirler MUST also enter at least one “non-pageant” solo to be eligible to participate in the Basic Skills pageant (open, Canadian or US Solo).
