From Sharon, PA (approx. 1 hr): Take Rte 11 N to State Rd exit toward OH 46 S. Continue on OH 46 to Clay St and turn R. Go approx.. 8 mi and turn R on Barnum Rd. Go approx.. 1 mile and turn L onto OH 84 (S Ridge E). School is on the right

From Erie, PA (approx. 1 hour): Take I-90W until you come to Exit 223 (OH 45). Turn L on OH 45 S (toward Cleveland). Turn R on Clay St and follow directions above from Sharon.

HIGH POINT AWARD to solo twirler with most points earned. Novice/Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced (division determined by solo classification). All solo events count 5 pts. for entering each event, plus points for placement: 5pts. for 1st, 4 pts. for 2nd, 3 pts. for 3rd, 2 pts. for 4th and 1 pt for 5th. (Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo and Special Beginner Basic not included.) 40 point minimum Forms available at registration desk.

- Level 1 Dance Twirl** (same as above; twirls restricted to no more than a 1 turn)
- Twirl Teams** – march music; 1 ½ - 3 minutes
- Duet Strut & Strut Teams** – Use own music; 1 – 3 minutes
- Novelty Teams** – must use some prop or equipment instead of, or in addition to standard baton – 1 ½ - 3 minutes
- Pom Teams** – Use own music; No Props; 1 ½ to 3 minutes
- Majorette Squads** – Jr Hi/ Sr Hi/ College - Short: Up to 4 min./ Long: 4-8 min.
- Color Guard** – Junior and Senior; Short Program/ Long Program
- Production Groups:** 10 members minimum; 4- 8 minutes
- Corps:** Floor, Street Parade and Mini – 10 twirling members minimum

(No specific pattern required –Time limit is 2 minutes maximum)

(Has not won TWO 1st places in Basic March)
- Beg. Basic March** – Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.

Girls Solo (Levels 1-5) Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

- Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo**– No more than 1 spin/2 elbows Time: 1 to 2 min.
- Level 2 (Novice) Solo**– No more than 2 spins/4 elbows Time: 1½ to 2 min.
- Level 3 (Beginner) Solo** - No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.
- Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo**– No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min
- Level 5 (Advanced) Solo** - No restrictions - Time – 2 to 2 ½ min.
- Boys/Mens Solo** (all levels)– Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time 1½ to 2 ½ min.
- Feature Twirler Solo** – Open to ANY twirler age 15+. Combo of 1 baton & novelty; standard twirling music – time: 1½ to 2 ½; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.
- Nov, Beg., Int. & Adv. Instate Solo** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time - same as solo classification. Ohio Residents only.
- Nov, Beg., Int. & Adv. Visitors. Solo** – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Time limit – same as solo classification. Out of state residents only
- Beg. Int. & Adv., Two-Baton** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time: 1½ to 2 minutes
- Beg. & Adv. Three-Baton** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over; Time: ½ to 2 min.
- Duet Twirl** – standard music- Avg. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time 1½ to 2½ min

+**Solo Dance Twirl** - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ use own music; 1 baton only

+**Solo Show Routine** — **Beg. & Adv** - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Use own music - any type of dance with baton & novelty
(Beg.Time :30-2 minutes; Adv Time: 1½ to 2 ½ minutes)

+**Duet Show Routine** – Same as solo show, novelties optional, Avg ages; 1:30-3:00

+**Solo Pom** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (Time: 1 ½ min. max – use own music)

+**Duet Pom** – Same as Solo Pom, Use averaged ages

+**Color Guard or Rifle/Sabre Solo** – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes

+**Color Guard Duet or Rifle Duet** – Same as Solo; Use Avg. Ages

+These events must be entered by Sunday, Apr 21 to be eligible to compete for awards

BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT (Level 1 & Level 2 Twirlers only) – Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Compete in 3 parts: Basic March, Costume Model and Solo
