Level 3 (Beginner) Solo- No more than 3 spins/6 elbows Time: 1 ½ - 2 min.

Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo – No more than 4 spins/8 elbows Time: 1 ½ to 2¼ min

**Level 5 (Advanced) Solo** - No restrictions - Time -2 to  $2\frac{1}{2}$  min.

**Boys/Mens Solo** – Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & over Time  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  to  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  min.

**Feature Twirler Solo** – Open to ANY twirler age 15+. Combination of 1baton & novelty; standard march music – time: 1½ to 2½; 1 baton minimum of 1 min.
