#### From Altoona, Pittsburgh and West:

Take 76 E to Exit 247 for I-283 toward Harrisburg Take PA 741 E exit toward Millersville Turn R onto Manor Ave; then turn L onto N George St FOR PARKING: At light, turn R on Frederick St, then L on Shenks Ln Parking lot is on the left just beyond Rec Center

#### From Philadelphia and East:

Take 76 W toward Harrisburg Take Exit 86 toward US 222 Reading/Lancaster Stay on 222 S/US 30 W, then keep R at fork to stay on US 30 W Take the PA 741 exit toward Millersville and follow directions above

#### From NY and NJ:

Take 78 W or 76 W to Rte 222 S and follow directions above

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. ALL publicity concerned with Twirling Unlimited Regional Competition will be handled through our headquarters. Each contestant winning  $1^{st}$  place and each group winning  $1^{st}$  place will be given official press releases. These in turn may be submitted by the winners to the media – newspapers, television, etc. No publicity relating to TU contests is to be submitted in any way other than the official press releases.

2. NO spectator admission! \$18 Facility/Registration fee replaces spectator admission fee. (Maximum of \$30 per family. If entering online – email for rebate).

3. Lanes for all Regional and Open events will be posted. It is the obligation of each twirler to report to both lanes if you have a conflict. No changing of position in the Regional competition will be allowed.

4. Awards for groups will be announced at the end of group competition (approximately noon). Awards for all open and Regional Novelty events will be presented immediately upon the conclusion of each division. Awards for Basic Skills, Beginner & Intermediate pageants will be presented when tabulation is complete near the end of the day. Awards for Miss TU Pageant and Regional Solo will be announced at the end of the competition.

5. Building owner, contest director, Twirling Unlimited or contest sponsor are not responsible for accidents, property loss, or injuries.

6. REGIONAL does not denote a geographic restriction. Contestants from any location and any organization are welcome at every Regional contest. No membership required.

7. In order to be eligible to compete in any pageant, a twirler must also enter open solo at their pageant level. Adv twirlers may enter Regional, State and/or open solo to fulfill this requirement.

8. Food will be available at the university concession stand

9. No Group entries, Regional event entries, or Pageant entries accepted after 5/19! Late entries must be RECEIVED in TU office by May 19 to be accepted. Do not mail <u>late</u> entries after mail deadline; they will not arrive in time!

#### MISS TU REGIONAL MAJORETTE- Separate Senior 18+ Division!

Age Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17, 18+ (The designation "Regional" is not restrictive, contestants may live in any location.)

This is a Three-part Event:

A. MODELING

All divisions optional dress length or costume. Model 50%; Interview 50%

**B. COMPETITION SOLO** 

1 baton only – time:  $1\frac{1}{2}$  to  $2\frac{1}{2}$  minutes. Performed to standard twirling music

C. INDIVIDUAL MUSIC EVENT (Show Routine or Solo Dance Twirl)
 Performed to music of the contestant's choice. Any type of twirl with dance permitted (novelties optional). Time:1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> to 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> minutes

Contestants must compete in all 3 aspects of this competition and the winner will be determined using equal credit for all 3 parts. *Note: Twirlers must also enter open solo to be eligible to compete in the pageant. Adv twirlers may use Regional or State Solo to meet this requirement.* 

<u>Awards</u>: 1-3 Overall Trophies

Individual medals for 1-3 in Model, Solo, Individual Music event Miss TU Majorette winners also receive flowers, banner, \$25 toward Savings Bond

## **REGIONAL SOLO**

The designation "Regional" does not restrict the contestants who may enter; they may live in any location.

Open to <u>all</u> levels. Time limit is  $1\frac{1}{2}$  to  $2\frac{1}{2}$  minutes from salute to salute. Divisions: *Individual ages for preliminaries*!

(0-6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16, 17, 18,19, 20 & over) Trophy for 1st place. The top 2 in <u>each age</u> category will re-twirl for the regional title. TwirlOff Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17 and 18+.

Twirl-Off Awards: Special plaque and banner for Title winner Custom Silver, Bronze medals for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>

### STATE SOLO CHAMPIONSHIPS (PENNSYLVANIA)

State Solo Championship - open to all levels; residents of Pennsylvania only. Time limit is 1½ to 2½ minutes from salute to salute. Divisions: 0-8, 9-11,12-14, 15 & Over.

### **REGIONAL FANCY STRUT**

Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. No specific pattern required (X strut, straight line, freestyle etc.) - time limit is 2 minutes maximum.

### **REGIONAL DUET TWIRL**

Time limit 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> to 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> minutes. Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (averaged ages) Performed to Standard Twirling Music

#### REGIONAL DUET STRUT (morning event)

Use Own Music; Time: 11/2 to 3 min. - Ages (Avg.): 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

## BEGINNER (Level 3) & INTERMEDIATE (Level 4) PAGEANTS

Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Contestants will compete in Model (Costume or Dress allowed), Twirl & Fancy Strut. Open to all contestants regardless of geographic residence. Banner, Trophy & Flower for winners. 3 place awards in model, twirl & strut and 3 places for overall pageant winners. 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> place overall added if more contestants. *Note: Twirlers must also enter open solo <u>at the same level</u> to be eligible to compete in the pageant.* 

#### **BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT**

Restricted to Levels 1 & 2 (Novice and Special Beginner) twirlers ONLY. Contestants will compete in Basic March, Costume Model & Solo – 3 place awards in Basic, Solo and Costume Model. 3 place winners overall. 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> overall added if more contestants. Divisions 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ *Note: Twirlers must also enter either Level 1 or Level 2 open solo to be eligible to compete in the pageant.* 

#### **REGIONAL TWO-BATON & REGIONAL THREE-BATON**

Time limit is 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> to 2 minutes for Two-Baton; <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> - 2 minutes for Three-Baton. Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over

# **REGIONAL GROUP COMPETITION**

Groups should bring your own player/speaker in case of technical difficulties. We will have a mic available for amplification, if necessary.

**GROUP AGES:** Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9); Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15.0 & over)

Corps: Minimum of 10 baton twirling members <u>Street Parade Corps</u> - Do a U floor formation; 2 min. time limit <u>Mini Corps</u> - 2 to 4 min. time limit. No formation required <u>Floor Corps</u> - 4 to 8 min. time limit.

Production Group - 10 member minimum, 4-8 min. time limit

All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-9); Large (10+ members) <u>Dance Twirl</u> – Use own music; Time limit: 1 ½ - 3 minutes <u>Twirl Teams</u> Use standard march music. 1 ½ - 3 minutes <u>Poms</u> - Use own music; Time Limit: 1½ - 3 minutes <u>Novelty Teams</u> – Use any equipment other than one baton; 1 ½ - 3 min. <u>Strut Teams</u> - Use own music; Time Limit: 1 – 3 min.

<u>Color Guard</u> (Jr & Sr) Short Program or Long Program, use own music <u>Dance Lines</u> (all types against each other) -Time Limit: 3 minutes Max.

Open Event: <u>Level 1 Dance Twirl Teams</u>. For new and developing teams – level of tricks restricted: no member may do more than a 1 turn, no more than 2 elbows, no high toss illusions. Awards: Level 1 medallion for each member.

#### **INDIVIDUAL OPEN EVENTS**

Note: Double entering 2 levels of the same open event is not permitted at Regionals.

- Beg. Dress Model: length of dress is optional; time is 1½ min. Max Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Int. & Adv. Dress Model : length of dress is optional; Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Beg. Costume Model (Best Appearing): with or without a baton time is 1½ minutes Maximum (no minimum) Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
  Int. & Adv. Costume Model (Best Appearing) -with or without a baton - time limit is 1½ minutes Maximum (no minimum) Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Novice, Beg. & Int. Fancy Strut no specific pattern required. (Advanced level enters Regional event) Time limit is 2 minutes Max. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Beg. Basic March performed in a square, singly or follow-the-leader (judge's discretion). Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+
- Adv. Basic March- performed in a square, singly or follow-the-leader (judge's discretion). Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

*NOTE: TU* rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.

Levels 1-5 Girls Solo Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

- Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo Has not won TWO 1st places in solo competition. Time limit is 1 to 2 minutes. No more than 1 spin/ 2 elbows/no toss illusion
- Level 2 (Novice) Solo not won 3 addt'l first places in solo time: 1½ to 2 minutes No more than 2 spins/ 4 elbows
- Level 3 (Beginner) Solo-not won 5 additional first places in solo Time: 1½ to 2 min No more than 3 spins/ 6 elbows.
- Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo- not won 8 addt'l 1st places in solo Time l ½ to 2 ¼ min. No more than 4 spins/ 8 elbows
- Level 5 (Advanced) Solo Time limit is 2 to 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> minutes. No restrictions

Boys Solo - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time Limit: 1 1/2 - 2 1/2 minutes

Feature Twirler Solo – Open to <u>any</u> twirler age 15+ - March Music –Combination of 1 baton & any novelty. Time Limit:  $2 - 2\frac{1}{2}$  min. (1 baton minimum of 1 minute).

Beg. & Int. Two-Baton - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time limit is 1½ to 2 minutes Beg. Three-Baton- Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15& over Time limit ½ -2 minutes (Adv. levels enter Regional event)

Beginner Duet Twirl- Avg. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+; Time limit: 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> to 2 min.

Color Guard (Flag) Solo or Rifle/Sabre Solo (morning events)\* – Use own music, Time: Max. 3 minutes; Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ \*Entries for this event not accepted after May 19
