From Northeast or Southeast (Canton, OH, Pittsburgh, PA, Roanoke, VA): From I-79/I-77: Merge onto 1-64 West via exit 101 toward Huntington Take Kanawha Turnpike Exit 55, toward WV-601 (0.3 mi) Slight left onto Kanawha Turnpike (1.7 mi) Turn left at light onto Chestnut Street, then take right onto Eagle Way

From West or Northwest (Columbus, OH, Huntington, WV): Take I-64 E Take the WV-25 Exit 53, and keep Left toward Dunbar Turn left onto 10Th St/WV-25. Continue to follow 10th St. (0.3 mi) 10th Street becomes Dunbar Bridge (0.2 mi) then turn slight right (0.06 mi) Turn right onto MacCorkle Ave SW/US60 (0.3mi) Turn right onto Chestnut Street and turn right onto Eagle Way

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. One of the philosophies of Twirling Unlimited is that there is too much unnecessary publicity by individual twirlers. This results in distrust by the media and a hohum attitude on the part of the public when a truly outstanding honor is achieved. In keeping with this, ALL the publicity concerned with Twirling Unlimited Regional Competitions will be handled with TU authorization. Each contestant winning a Regional Title and each group winning a Regional Title will be given official press releases. These may be submitted to the media by the winners – newspapers, television, etc. No publicity relating to TU contests is to be submitted without the official press releases. Failure to comply with this standard will result in rejection of future entries and participation in Twirling Unlimited competitions.

2. Door admission: \$7/adults; \$5 for seniors and non-competing children Everyone pays door admission except performing contestants.

3. Divisions for all Regional and Open events will be posted at each lane. It is the obligation of each twirler to report to both lanes if you have a conflict.

4. Awards for all individual open events will be posted upon the conclusion of each division. Group awards will be announced at the end of group competition. Awards for individual Regional Novelty events will be posted as tabulation is complete. Awards for pageants and Regional Solo will be announced near the end of the day as tabulation is completed. Miss TU pageant will be announced at the end of the competition.

5. Building owner, contest director, Twirling Unlimited or contest sponsor are not responsible for accidents, property loss or injuries.

6. Remember: REGIONAL does not denote a geographic restriction. <u>Contestants</u> from any location and any organization are welcome at every TU Regional.

7. In order to be eligible to compete in any pageant, a twirler must also enter OPEN solo at same level as pageant. (Score Sheet only not permitted) Adv. twirlers may enter Regional, State, or open solo to fulfill this requirement

8. COVID protocols: Currently, masks are optional at this competition. Anyone who wishes to wear a mask is encouraged to do so, but they will not be required for contestants or spectators. Registered participants will be notified if this changes. Participants and spectators are encouraged to be aware of social distancing.

MISS TU REGIONAL MAJORETTE (Including separate 18+ division)

Age Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17, 18 & Over (*Use age as of day of contest*) Note: The designation "Regional" does not restrict the contestants who may enter, twirlers may live in any location and be from any organization.

This is a three- part contest.

A. MODELING & INTERVIEW

All age divisions optional dress length OR costume. Model 50%, Interview 50%

B. COMPETITION SOLO

One baton only – time limit 1 ½ to 2 ½ minutes Performed to standard twirling music

C. INDIVIDUAL MUSIC EVENT (SHOW TWIRL or SOLO DANCE TWIRL) Performed to music of contestant's choice. Any type of twirl with dance permitted; novelties optional. Time: 1¹/₂ to 2 ¹/₂ minutes. Timing begins and ends with music. (*Bring your own player as backup in case of technical difficulties.*)

Contestants must compete in all 3 aspects of this pageant and the winner will be determined using equal credit for all 3 parts.

Note: Twirlers must also enter open solo to be eligible to compete in the pageant Awards: Trophies for 1-3 Overall

Individual medals for 1-3 in Model, Solo, IM Event

Miss TU Majorettes also receive flowers, banner & \$25 "Savings Bond" check

REGIONAL SOLO

<u>The designation "Regional" is a status level and does not restrict the contestants</u> who may enter. Contestants from any organization or location may participate.

Divisions: (5 Championship divisions – including separate Senior Division!) *Preliminaries: Individual ages!* (0-6,7, 8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15,16, 17,18,19, 20 +) The top 2 in <u>each age category will twirl again for the Regional title.</u>

Champion TwirlOff Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17 and 18+.

Awards: Trophy for 1st place in each preliminary age division Plaque and Banner for Regional Twirloff Champions Custom Regional Silver, Bronze medals for 2nd & 3rd in twirloff.

STATE SOLO CHAMPIONSHIPS (West Virginia)

State Solo Championship - open to all levels; residents of West Virginia only. Time limit is 1½ to 2½ minutes from salute to salute. Divisions: 0-8, 9-11,12-14, 15 & Over.

REGIONAL FANCY STRUT

Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. No specific pattern required (X Strut, straight line, or free floor pattern are acceptable)– time limit is 2 minutes maximum.

REGIONAL DUET TWIRL

Time limit 1¹/₂ to 2¹/₂ min. March Music. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (avg. ages)

REGIONAL DUET STRUT

Time: 1¹/₂ - 3 min. Use own music Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ (averaged ages)

REGIONAL TWO-BATON & REGIONAL THREE-BATON

Age Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over Time limit is 1¹/₂ to 2 minutes for 2-Baton; Time is ¹/₂ - 2 minutes for 3-Baton

BEGINNER (Level 3) & INTERMEDIATE (Level 4) PAGEANTS

Divisions: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15 & Over. Contestants will compete in Model (costume or dress), Solo & Fancy Strut. (Solo level determines Pageant level). Open to all contestants regardless of geographic residence. *Note: Twirlers must also <u>enter</u> open solo <u>at same level</u> to be eligible to compete in the pageant.*

BASIC SKILLS PAGEANT

Restricted to Level 1 and Level 2 (Special Beginner and Novice) twirlers ONLY. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+. Contestants will compete in Basic March, Costume Model & Solo. *Note: twirlers must also <u>enter</u> open Level 1 or Level 2 solo to be eligible to compete in the pageant.*

All Pageant Awards: 3 place awards in Strut (or Basic March), Solo, and Model. All pageants: Banner, Trophy & Flowers for winners. Trophies for 1-3 place winners overall. 4th overall trophy for groups that have 11-14 contestants; 5th overall trophy for groups with 15 contestants or more.

REGIONAL GROUP COMPETITION

(Coaches: please bring your own music player as a backup, in case of technical difficulties.)

GROUP AGES: Pee Wee (0-6.9); Tiny Tot (7.0-8.9); Juvenile (9.0-11.9); Junior (12.0-14.9); Senior (15.0 & over)

Corps: Minimum of 10 twirling members <u>Street Parade Corps</u> - Do a U formation; 2 min. time limit <u>Mini Corps</u> - 2 to 4 min. time limit. No formation required <u>Floor Corps</u> - 4 to 8 min. time limit. <u>Production Groups</u> - 4- 8 min. time limit - 10 member minimum

All Teams: Small (3-5 members); Medium (6-9); Large (10+ members) <u>Dance Twirl</u> – Use own music; no props; 1 baton only Time: 1½ - 3 minutes <u>Twirl Teams</u> Use TU standard march music; 1 baton only; 1½ - 3 minutes <u>Poms</u> - Use own music; mounts restricted; Time Limit: 1½ - 3 minutes <u>Novelty Teams</u> – Use any equipment other than one baton; 1½ - 3 min. <u>Strut Teams</u> - Use own music; 1 baton only; Time Limit: 1 – 3 min. <u>Dance Lines –</u> all types of dance lines compete together for Regional title

Color Guard (Jr & Sr) Short Program or Long Program, use own music

Open Event: <u>Level 1 Dance Twirl Teams</u>. For new and developing teams – level of twirls restricted – see rules for specifics! Awards: No trophy- Level 1 medallion for each team member.

OPEN EVENTS

Beg. Dress Model: length of dress optional; time limit is 1¹/₂ minutes Max Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Int. &Adv. Dress Model: length of dress is optional; time limit is 1 ¹/₂ minutes Max. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Beg. Costume Model: with or without baton – time:1½ minutes Max Ages: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Int. & Adv. Costume Model: with or without a baton - time limit is 1¹/₂ minutes Maximum. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Novice, Beg. & Int. Fancy Strut - no specific pattern required. (Adv. Strut should enter Regional Strut event) Time limit is 2 minutes Max. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Beg. Basic March - performed in a square singlyAges: 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+Adv. Basic March - performed in a square singlyAges: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

NOTE: TU rules limit the number of toss turns and rolls which may be executed by twirlers in the developmental levels of solo twirl. Check TU rules for specifics.

Girls Solo Ages (all Levels): 0-6, 7-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+

Level 1 (Special Beginner) Solo – Has not won TWO 1st places in solo competition. Time limit is 1 to 2 minutes. No more than 1 spin/ 2 elbows/no high toss illusion

- Level 2 (Novice) Solo Has not won 3 additional first places in solo competition Time limit is 1½ to 2 minutes. No more than 2 spins/ 4 elbows
- Level 3 (Beginner) Solo -not won 5 additional first places in solo Time: 1½ to 2 min No more than 3 spins/ 6 elbows.

Level 4 (Intermediate) Solo- not won 8 addt'l 1st places in solo Time 1½ to 2¼ min. No more than 4 spins/ 8 elbows

Level 5 (Advanced) Solo - Time limit is 2 to 2 1/2 minutes. No restrictions

Boys/Mens Solo - Ages 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time Limit: 1 1/2 - 2 1/2 minutes

Feature Twirler Solo – Open to <u>any</u> twirler age 15+ - March Music –Combination of 1 baton and any novelty. Time Limit: $2 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ min. (1 baton minimum of 1 min.)

Beg. & Int. Two-Baton - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time limit is 1¹/₂ to 2 minutes (Adv. level should enter Regional event)

Beg. Three-Baton - Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+ Time limit is $\frac{1}{2}$ -2 minutes (Adv. level should enter Regional event)

Beginner Duet Twirl – Avg. Ages: 0-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15+; Time limit: 1½ to 2 min. (Adv. level should enter Regional event)

Color Guard Solo or Rifle/Sabre Solo – Ages 0-14, 15+ - Use own music Time: Maximum 3 minutes
